You are invited to enter the Under 12 Championship at which selection of the "Most Promising Junior 2017/2018" will be made. Under 12 includes children who are under 10, 11 or 12 on 01/09/17 and we will again select our 30 player Under 11 County Squad from entrants to the Under 12 Championship. The U11 girls squad will be selected and managed by Chess Coach, Olivia Smithies.

This year, there will be £100 in prize money for the highest placed player(s) in the U12 Championship. Unfortunately we didn't win any prize money in the Audio Chess Grand Prix last year. We will also present a special rosette to whoever is considered by me, (Pat Armstrong) "The Most Promising Junior". Wey Valley Chess, Surrey offers the Under 12 Champion title and Foster-Yeow Cup to the highest scoring entrant (ties will be decided by 'sum of progressive scores' and if this fails, 'sum of opponents' scores'). Eligibility for the title is based on eligibility to play for Wey Valley - Surrey in EPSCA events.

If you were Under 9 on 01/09/17 you should enter the Under 9 Team Selection event and try for a place in the Wey Valley-Surrey U9 team which also plays in the English Primary Schools Chess Association (EPSCA) Team Championships. Rosettes or medals will be awarded to all who score 3 or more points out of 5.

Clocks will be used, all the moves to be played in the 45 minutes on each clock. This time limit is approximately that used in the EPSCA National Team Championships which we enter each year. It is important that all contenders for places in the Under 9/Under 11 and Girls Under 11 teams play in this event if possible. There will be refreshments on sale, including hot food and drinks. The weather may not be good, so bring along a quiet desk top game you can play between rounds in case it is impossible to go outside. Muddy feet risk default!

NOTE: Everyone plays in every round, no one is knocked out. If you need to leave before the end, please let a controller know. All Wey Valley tournaments are graded giving players a ranking in relation to other regular players in Wey Valley, Surrey tournaments. Once again this year, the results of the U12 section will be returned to the ECF for rapid play grading.
